## Location:

Newport is located on the Redcliffe Peninsular northeast of Brisbane.

## Getting there:

- By road from Brisbane 40 minutes.
- By road from the airport 30 minutes
- By rail from the airport 60 minutes (connection dependent)



## Where to stay:

The Redcliffe Peninsular is rich with accommodation options.

## Sailing Venue:

Newport is the home of the Moreton Radio Yacht Squadron and is sailed three times a week all year round. Wind is predominately from the east and the elevated controlled area is shared between the southern and western banks depending on conditions.



# Sailing Conditions

The prevailing wind in February is from the eastern half of the compass in a reliable sea breeze. In these conditions the western bank is used for ranking events, providing a windward leeward course with ample length.

The resident club sails three times a week usually from the southern bank and uses well less than half of the area available for the Nationals. All Controlled Areas are elevated, grassed and in good order. The pontoon is available although most sailors choose to launch from the nearest bank.

The area is tidal with generally clean water and no through tidal flow.
